Time commitment

- Entire school year (September 2019 – May 2020)
- Wednesdays 4 – 6 pm and one half day shift (9:00 am – 1:30 pm or 1– 5:30 pm) either Saturday or Sunday

- E-Team runs whether or not school is in session! If you will be away for more than 2 weeks for family vacations or camps you should not apply for this position.
